



Prof. Dr. IHSAN ISIK SHORT BIO

Dr. Ihsan Isik is currently working as a full time tenured professor of international banking and finance at Rowan University in Glassboro, New Jersey, USA. He also serves as the founding Chairman and CEO of the American Turkish Chamber of Commerce (ATCOM), headquartered in Cherry Hill, New Jersey. ATCOM operates as the American partner of the Independent Industrialists and Businessmen Association (MUSIAD), one of the largest business alliances in Turkey. Dr. Isik is also serving as the board member of the World Turkish Business Council – Americas Committee, an initiative by the Union of Chambers and Exchanges of Turkey (TOBB), responsible from North America, South America and Caribbean.

Dr. Isik received his B.S. in Management with high honors from the Middle East Technical University, (Ankara, Turkey, 1992), his M.S. in Finance from Texas Tech University, (Lubbock, Texas, 1995), his M.A. in Economics (1997) and his Ph.D. in Financial Economics from University of New Orleans (New Orleans, Louisiana, 2000). Dr. Isik's doctoral dissertation has been recognized by the UNO faculty as one of the top three dissertations ever produced in the doctoral program. Before joining Rowan University in Fall 2001, Dr. Isik had worked for the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) for two years as an assistant professor of finance and accounting. His research and teaching interest is in the field of international financial markets and institutions. He has several national and international conference presentations (ERF, FMA, SWFAD, IMDA) and research papers on banking, of which two appeared in the tier-one banking journal, *Journal of Banking and Finance*, where they have been the 12'th and 17'th most requested articles in 2002 and 2003, respectively. Dr. Isik is also the recipient of several best paper and outstanding research awards for his scholarly activities, such as from the Merrill Lynch Center For the Study of International Financial Services and Markets, International Applied Business Research Conference, European Applied Research Conference, American Society of Business and Behavioral Sciences Conference and Rowan University. Dr. Isik has worked as a consultant on a number of projects for Istanbul Municipality and Central Bank of Turkey.

Prof. Isik's essays on current economic and financial affairs appear in some Turkish and international dailies such as *Zaman*, *Star*, *Referans* and *Forum*. Dr. Isik is a member of the International Financial Management Association and he is a research fellow of the EU funded Economic Research Forum (ERF), a think-tank group working on the MENA region. Prof. Isik is married with twin daughters and resides in New Jersey, USA.
